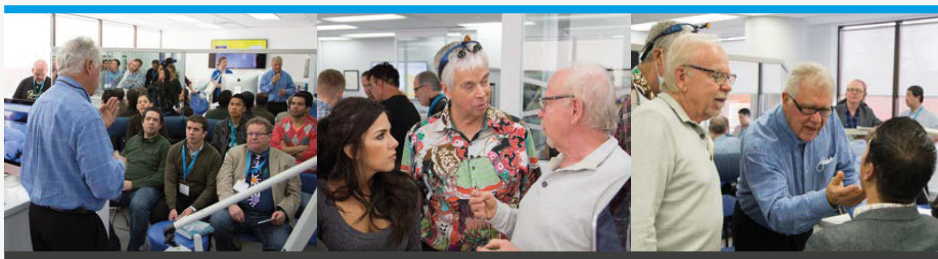

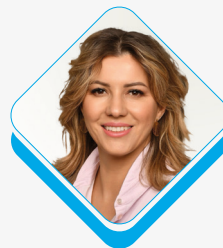

In Office Setting: Dr Emilia Joniec clinic – bonding, case records, at the most 3 to 4 patients (1 assess records, planning, bonding, disarticulation and ILSE – 2 first AW reposition or ram turbos, increase to 18x18 US Aw's and assess for reposition – 1 reposition 3rd appointment after 19x18 US Aw's) – this is about 1/2 a day – could add photography and video of exam.
